The Geraldine L. Anschutz Memorial Trust Scholarship

For high school seniors at Wilson High School

Criteria:

- Applicants must be candidates for current year's graduation from Wilson High School.
- Applicants must be pursuing a formal education beyond high school.
- Applicants must show demonstrated scholastic ability.
- Applicants must show demonstrated qualities of leadership and citizenship.
- Applicants must show financial need.
- Applications are due by March 31 and should be returned to:

For students in good standing qualifying for graduation from Wilson High School who are also members of Saint Wenceslaus Catholic Church

Criteria:

- Member of Saint Wenceslaus Catholic Church, and attendance of CCD and CYO.
- Enrolled as a full-time student in college. Preference will be given to first year college students who graduated from High School in the Spring Semester, however if there are no such applicants scholarships may be awarded to students who are not new college students.

- Applicants must attend an accredited post-secondary institution.

Criteria:

- Applicants must be graduates or candidates for graduation from Ellsworth High School.
- Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or above.
- Applicants should be planning to major in either meteorology or the medical field. Preference will be given to applicants planning to major in meteorology.
- Submit an essay, one page or less, outlining your goals for the course of study and eventual career.

- Student in good standing qualifying for graduation from Wilson High School in Kansas.
- Attending any accredited post secondary institution.
- Complete a one-page, double spaced essay, "Why do you want to further your education?"
- Applications are due by March 31 and should be returned to:

Charles & Velma Westerman Scholarship

For graduates of or candidates for graduation from Ellsworth High School

Criteria:

- Applicants must be graduates of or candidates for graduation from Ellsworth High School.
- Applicants must have a cumulative GPA either in high school or college of 3.0 or above based on a 4.0 scale.
- If the applicants are college students, they must be progressively working toward a degree.
- Applicants must submit an essay (one page or less) that outlines their goals for a course of study and eventual career.
- The scholarship committee may give monies to one or more applicants.
- The committee may take into consideration the need of the applicant, including other scholarships which may have been awarded to the applicant.
- Equal consideration shall be given to both high school and college applicants regardless of their course of study or career selection.
